


Transport Rules

- The school day starts at 9:00am and carpark gates are open for morning drop off between 8:40am and 9:10am.
- The school day ends at 2:15pm on a Monday and 3:15pm Tuesday – Friday. The carpark gates are open between 1:50pm-2:25pm on a Monday and between 2:50pm- 3:25pm Tuesday till Friday.
- At all times, please follow staff directions to keep children safe.
- You will be directed when to access and leave the carpark.
- To drive in the main carpark, you enter from the top and exit from the bottom next to gate 1 as shown on one of the pictures.
- The speed limit is 15mph.
- Gate 1 to Gate 2 is staff parking so beware of staff parking or leaving.
- Cone spaces are available for pupils that need extra support and these cars will be waved down by the member of staff on gate 1, when appropriate to do so.
- Buses will be waved down when it is safe and appropriate to do so by the member of staff on gate 1.
- Follow directions of staff on gate 2 to park your vehicle.
- DO NOT drive over or park on the walkways under any circumstance, this allows us to keep pedestrians safe.
- DO NOT park in the bus parking bays at the start of transport
- To avoid accidents, only use the designated walkways to walk around the carpark.
- Please be vigilant for children when driving around the carpark.
- Please turn your vehicle engine off when you arrive on the car park.
- Please be aware that if you have a larger vehicle you will be asked to park around the outside of the carpark, when possible.
- Please be courteous of other drivers, pupils and staff when reversing and driving around the carpark.
- Please be patient if there is a pupil struggling. This may involve staff supporting and stopping traffic.
- If you need support, please speak to a member of staff on gate 3.
- We politely remind you to ensure that children wear a seatbelt in a moving vehicle when on site.
- If you need to have a discussion with class teams, please arrange sufficient time. This allows the gates to be locked and pupils to access the space.
- Please note that by driving down on the outside of traffic you are not only on the wrong side of the road but could also cause serious congestion and accidents.
